The new year begins with a significant anniversary in our life together as pastor and congregation. January 1st marks the one year anniversary of my work among you as your pastor. One change that affects Grace in an significant way is that on January 1st, the three separate lay leader rosters in the ELCA, Associates in Ministry, Deaconesses, and Diaconal Ministers, are consolidated into one roster, now simply called Deacons. In

our Synod we also have a Synodical Deacon roster. Starting January first their official designation becomes Synod Parish Deacons. Within the work of the congregation, they will simply addressed "Deacon" as they are now. Some additional details about both types of deacons will be shared at the congregational meeting.
