#### **BUILDING CONSULTANT VISIT**

Dear people of Grace Lutheran Church, ties, Mr. Spann made many recommendations.

On Thursday, April 20th, Jeff Spann a church building consultant from the ELCA's Mission Investment Fund, accepted our request to visit our property and give us feedback in three specific areas:

I. Curb Appeal/ Hospitality (how inviting our property is from the outside)

II. Our Sanctuary, with special attention to the Narthex III. The Usable Life of our facilities, especially in regards to the need to replace the flat roofs and Fellowship Hall roof.

After an extensive tour of the facili-

mendations. For outside curb appeal and hospitality, he recommended ways to

increase how much of the Sanctuary building is visible Highland from Ave. and the parking lots across the street, ways to make the Highland classroom wing appealing more from the outside, and several suggestions for signage and parking.

He also made many suggestions regarding the Narthex and Sanctuary to increase their usability and hospitality, including the exterior restrooms, the size of Narthex, the a nursery or "wiggle room", making access to the pews more comfortable, lighting, and alternative locations for the music program components.

Mr. Spann indicated that he believed the building units have significant usable life left in them. Thus, he recommended replacing the roofs now and made a few suggestions regarding how that could be done with the flat roods in particular.

The rest of the conversation centered around cost. Because there are actually very few structural changes being suggested, the costs of these modifications would not be nearly as much as adding buildings would likely be.

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Thus it should be affordable an amount to make kind of the changes that we probably can't afford not to make for the sake of the future of our mission and ministry. We will discuss this more at the June congregational meeting. In the meantime, share any questions or suggestions you might have with me or any other parts of the leadership team.
