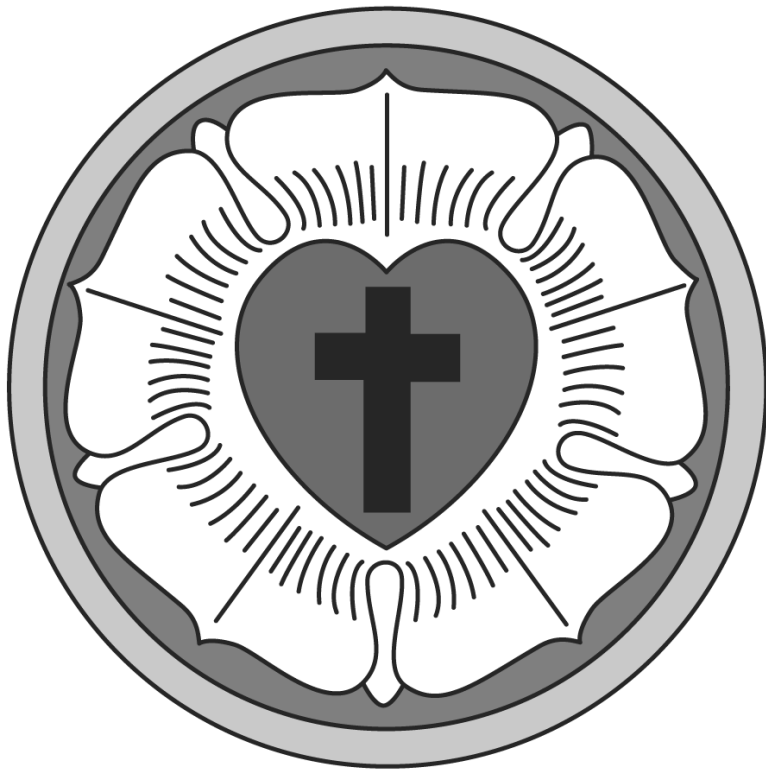

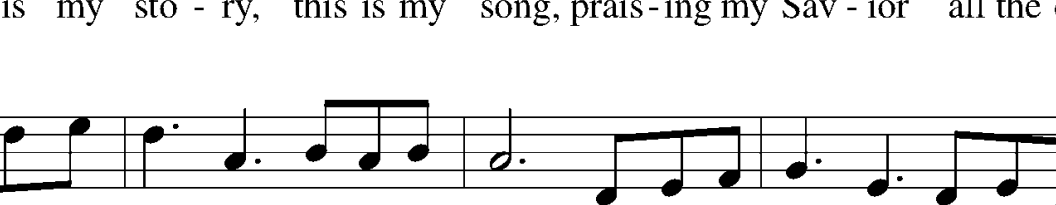

company of the saints, and into the glorious company of the saints in light.

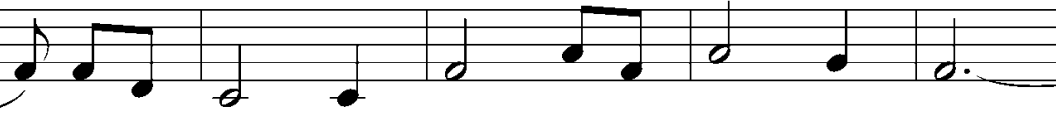
